


Below and to the right is one of Brian Stas' winter projects - Brian wanted one pit box to handle both F2D and GX events.

Rumors Facts Etc


KEN HARGREAVES: Ken recently came by NECN headquarters and dropped off 200 professionally cut and tied F2D streamers-a very generous donation to the cause.


