SHAYLENE VADER TAKES SPORTSMAN

AUGUST 27, 2006 – EAST HAMPTON, CT – Nine New England combat pilots were on hand for this one. The weather was just overcast to start, however by round two the rain came and stayed.

By day's end the Salmon River State Forest was rain soaked and so were all the participants.

Shaylene Vader jumped into the early lead with a two cut round one win. In round two, Jeff Vader posted his second consecutive good win to lead at the halfway point. Neil Simpson also had a good round two win and was running a close second to Jeff. Round three started with Neil and Jeff flying to a low scoring draw. Matt Stas then turned in his third good flight seizing the contest lead in the process. Going into the final round Matt had 1965 points, Jeff had 1860 points and Neil had 1645 points.

In the final round Glenn Simpson and Neil Simpson finished their day with good wins over Will Rogers and Shay Vader, respectively. In the final match Matt and Jeff flew to a low scoring draw allowing Neil to steal the contest win. Matt finished second, Jeff third and Glenn fourth. Shaylene was fifth overall taking home the Sportsman "gold" in the process.

BRIAN STAS, NEIL SIMPSON, JOE FUSTOLO & DICK SHERMAN ARE THE TOP FOUR

SHAYLENE VADER IS THE SPORTSMAN WINNER

SEPTEMBER 4, 2006-WORCESTER, MA -This year's New England Championships attracted ten pilots for the seventeenth annual running of this very successful Formula GX happening. The location was Boynton Park in Worcester, Massachusetts. The weather, after a rainout Sunday, was near perfect, on Monday, except for a strong breeze that was pesky at times.

Jeff Vader got off to the best start posting a three cut win. Brian Stas, Paul Kubek and Neil Simpson were close each posting two cut wins. In round two Jeff and Brian flew to a one cut apiece draw while Neil got a three cut win over Paul to take over the contest lead. Joe Fustolo and Shaylene Vader each used good round two wins to move into contention. Round three started Jeff and Neil mid-airing early in there match to sink back towards the field. Brian got a three cut win over Shay while Joe got a two cut win over Paul to take over first and second place at the three quarter point. Dick Sherman took over third with a three cut round three win while Neil and Jeff were clinging to fourth and fifth. Going into the final round it was Brian (2065pts), Joe (1855pts), Dick (1850pts), Neil (1650pts) and Jeff (1440pts). The final two flights of the contest would prove meaningful. In the first of these Neil Simpson got a two cut win over Dick Sherman to put pressure on the leaders. In the final Joe faced off against Brian. Joe got a cut early but Brian came back with a cut of his own to get a draw in the match and the contest win in the process. When it all shook out the top four were Brian (2575pts), Neil (2380pts), Joe (2365pts) and Dick (2250pts). Shaylene Vader took home the Sportsman "gold" finishing with 1730 points.



Points are awarded in decending order for the first ten places in each contest (1st Place = 10pts, 2nd Place = 9pts etc.) Total possible points is the number of contests participated in multiplied by ten. Participation in no less then 50% of the New England regular season GX meets is the elegibility requirement for a season championship award.


