



From the Editor

TO ALL NEW ENGLAND CONTEST COMPETITORS:

The tentative 2008 contest schedule can be found on page eleven of this issue, as well as on the website. It is tentative as to the accuracy of some of the dates, however, I believe all the listed events will come to fruition. You will find twelve Formula GX contests (down from fourteen last season) and four F2D meets (down from five last season). Please know that this is due to a lack of flying sites, not to a lack of financial resources or a willingness to run more events. I suspect a lot of you think sixteen events is plenty, however, for those amongst you who would like to see a few more, the solution is simple, get us a flying site. If you can secure a site, monies from the NECN contest fund are available to cover any and all costs. I will act as contest director, secure the sanction, the certificate of insurance and take care of the AMA contest report following the contest. Your reward, besides an additional contest, is that you can choose what combat event we run. It could be GX, F2D, 1/2A, Fast whatever, your choice.

One last thing, PLEASE. We have two Connecticut contests this year at the Salmon River State Forest in East Hampton, Connecticut. Connecticut was once a hot spot for New England Combat. We have almost no active flyers left in that geographic area and attendance has been very light for a year or two now. We need to maintain a presence in Connecticut so that our geographic base doesn't become narrower and our potential for the next new competitor smaller. Please make the long trip to support these contests. I believe it to be very important.
