

Wingbuster Shootout

CHRIS SARNOWSKI, NEIL SIMPSON AND PAUL KUBEK TAKE THE TROPHY SPOTS

August 23, 2014ó HALIFAX, MA ó The Wingbuster Shootout attracted five pilots for a day of Formula GX action. The weather was comfortable with partial cloud cover and warm temperatures. The grounds at the Wingbuster control line facility were manicured and very green.

Round one action saw Joe Fustolo and Chris Sarnowski get off to good starts each earning one cut wins. Round two started with a match-up between Joe and Chris with the latter earning a one cut win. At the halfway point Chris had the clear lead followed by Brian Stas who had posted two good scores. Round three saw Chris stay hot earning a one cut win over Brian and at that point it was clear that the rest of us were flying for second place. Going into round four it was Chris leading with everyone else closely bunched well behind his pace. The final three matches would sort things out. In the first of these matches Paul Kubek earned a two cut win over Joe emerging as a contender in the process. Next Joe and Brian flew to a low scoring draw hurting both of their chances. In the final Neil Simpson, who was flying steady after a slow start, secured an airtime win over Chris sneaking into second place in the process. The final order of finish was Chris, Neil and Paul.

Maine Jet Rally 2014

CHRIS SARNOWSKI, NEIL SIMPSON AND PAUL KUBEK ARE TOP THREE

SEPTEMBER 6, 2014 - SANFORD, ME - The Maine Jet Rally was a four day extravaganza that featured radio control airplanes, of all types, with an emphasis on RC jets. There was also RC helicopters, off-road RC car racing, model rockets, control-line flying and last, but not least demos featuring real air show pilots. The New England Combat Association was privileged to receive an invitation to run a control line combat contest as part of Saturdays schedule. Participation in this event, which attracted thousands of people, exposed what we do to a wide cross section of people, who already have an interest in aviation. The weather was very warm, partly sunny with a strong breeze.

Following the first round Chris Sarnowski and Neil Simpson were in the lead each posting two cut 725 point wins. In round two Chris and Neil flew to a one cut apiece draw leaving them tied atop the leader board at the halfway point. In round three Neil flew Joe Fustolo to a 410 point draw while Chris and Paul Kubek were posting the same score. As a result Neil and Chris remained tied and in the clear contest lead. The final two matches would determine the winner. In the first of these matches Joe and Chris flew to 510 point draw. This seemed to leave the door open for Neil as he faced off with Brian Stas in the final match. Brian had been having a bad day due to a variety of circumstances that have humbled all of us in various matches and at various contests, however in this match Brian would not be denied getting the best of Neil three cuts to one.

New England Championships

CHRIS SARNOWSKI, BRIAN STAS & NEIL SIMPSON ARE THE TOP THREE

AUGUST 31, 2014-HALIFAX, MA -This year & New England Championships was the twenty fifth annual running of this very successful Formula GX event. The location, again this year, was the Wingbuster club field in Halifax, Massachusetts. The grounds were manicured and very green. The weather was warm, humid and partly cloudy with a fairly strong breeze.

Round one saw Chris Sarnowski get off to the best start posting a three cut win over Joe Fustolo in a very well flown match where Joe posted two cuts of his own. Brian Stas and Neil Simpson posted two cut wins of their own finishing round one in close pursuit of Chris. In round two Brian scored a two cut to one win over Chris while Joe was getting past Neil by the same margin of victory. At the half way point Brian had the lead with 1350 points followed closely by Chris, Joe and Neil all within two to three hundred points of the leader. In round three Brian and Joe flew to a low scoring draw while Neil and Chris did only slightly better flying to a one cut apiece draw. Going into the final round Brian had 1660 points followed by Chris with 1640 points, Neil with 1535 points and Joe still in the mix with 1440 points. In Joe final match he flew Paul Kubek to a low scoring draw while Chris was earned a 625 two cut win over the same opponent. in the semi-final match. In the last match Brian and Neil flew to a 510 point draw. When the dust settled Chris had finished in first place, Brian was second and Neil third.

The top three flyers received beautiful awards. Thank you, as always, to the Wingbusters Model Airplane Club for allowing us to use their fine facility. It truly is combat heaven.

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
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
