Wingbuster Summer Classic

PAUL KUBEK, NEIL SIMPSON & BRIAN STAS ARE TOP THREE

JULY 26, 20156 HALIFAX, MA 6 The Wingbuster Summer Classic attracted six pilots for a day of Formula GX action. The weather was partly cloudy with just a little rain early and increasing humidity as the day progressed. Temperatures topped out around eighty degrees. The grounds at the Wingbuster control line facility were manicured and very green.

Round one action saw Paul Kubek post a three cut win while Neil Simpson and Brian Stas tried to keep pace posting two cut wins of their own. In round two Paul outflew Neil two cuts to one to maintain his contest lead. Also in round two Matt Stas secured a one cut victory over his dad to create a log jam in the battle to keep pace with Paul. At the halfway point Paul had 1555 points. Brian, Matt and Neil were all sitting at 1025 points well off Pauløs cumulative score. In round three Paul secured his contest lead flying Matt to a one cut apiece draw. Neil got past Brian with a low scoring one cut win where both pilots spent considerable time on the ground following a line tangle crash. In the final round Neil posted a one cut win over Rick Clark. Matt flew Chris Sarnowski to a very low scoring draw where both pilots missed considerable airtime. This left Paul in a position to fly very conservative in the final match against Brian, as just airtime points would be enough to secure the contest win. Brian took full advantage of that situation posting a three cut win. When it all sorted out the final order of finish was Paul, Neil and Brian. (continued on page six)

NEIL SIMPSON AND BRIAN STAS FINISH ONE-TWO IN SPEED LIMIT SHOOTOUT

AUGUST 9, 2015 ó EAST BROOKFIELD, MA ó In New England the number of active speed limit flyers has dwindled these last few seasons. At this point in time we have just seven active flyers. On this contest weekend we had one out with an injury, one working and one on vacation in Europe. That left only four of us to carry the combat torch. This prompted a contest day switch from our traditional Formula GX rules to our Shootout rules which are inspired by a rule structure, from the Pacific Northwest, which is the brainchild of Gene Pape. Thank you Gene. The rules are so simple that the pitmen can judge the event. This is necessary because if you only have four guys two are flying, two are pitting and there is no one left over to judge. The contest was flown in triple elimination format. The rule structure is simple, most cuts wins, however if you land or crash, for any reason during the three minute match period you lose. If you both come down you both lose. These rules allow four guys to have a fun and competitive day of combat flying with no need for any additional people to do the judging.

Paul Kubek versus Chris Sarnowski was the first match. A mid-air where both planes came down gave both pilots an early loss. Their tough days continued when both guys lost again in rounds two and three. This left Brian Stas and Neil Simpson, who were both undefeated, to battle it out for the shootout win. In there first match Brian got an early cut and then trapped Neil down low and got two additional quick cuts. At that point Neil was basically willing to sacrifice the win to save equipment, however, with about one minute to go Briangs engine begun to sputter and then quit. Seems someone had gauged how much fuel he needed just a little too closely. Remember, if you come down you lose. In the next match, Neil believing in fate and inspired by the belief the combat gods were smiling on him, flew much better. It was a barn burner of a match where both pilots flew extremey well Neil just getting the better of it four cuts to three.





AUGUST 15, 2015- HALIFAX, MA 6 The weather was sizzling hot, low nineties to be exact, however dead calm conditions, a blazing sun and high humidity pushed the real feel temperature passed the mid-nineties. The Wingbusters club field was manicured however it was starting to brown slightly from a lack of rain. Five contestants were on hand for the second contest of the 2015 New England F2D season.

At the end of two rounds one pilot had been sent home in this double elimination affair. Chris Sarnowski was undefeated while Paul Kubek, Brian Stas and Neil Simpson were sitting at one win and one loss. In round three Chris stayed undefeated giving Paul his second loss in a battle that might have been the best flown match of the day.
